Our 'business' meeting is Thursday 16 June at HIRL – 7.30 pm.

Excursion to the Four Posts and Hewitt Park on the Wannon River. That will be on Sunday 19 June and we will be leaving from the Hamilton Visitor Centre at 10 am. Please note the later than usual starting time (in deference to those who find it hard to face the shorter daylight hours in June!). We will probably have an early finish, around or soon after lunch time. Fungi and some early orchids will be the main attractions at this time of year. The river gorge on the NE corner of Hewitt Park will provide some attractive scenes. We will stop first at Four Posts Streamside Reserve – take the right fork in the road some 500 m from Four Posts (it leads past the old quarry gate) and drive to the end to park on the disused road.

A decision will be forthcoming at the meeting on 16 June.
